

SUGGESTIONS FOR LOCAL ACTIVISM

Please find below a list of suggestions on local activism,

- Leaflet Handouts and Letterbox Drops Leaflets can be distributed outside local shops directly into peoples hands or dropped into letter boxes.
- Local Community Meetings if you feel informed enough on the issue, invite the
 public to a community meeting where you can openly discuss the concerns and
 answer questions from local people. This is about creating discussion and
 engaging with members of the public.
- Car stickers- A smaller initiative would be to print the logo onto a sticker for car boot/bumpers. Very simple way to get the word out to drivers behind you.
- Local Information Stalls- These are a very effective way to connect with people on the ground.
 - Holding a stall requires excellent interpersonal skills when dealing with members of the public on such contentious topics.
 - If you want to set up and run an information stall in your local community, please contact us and we will provide workshops and training on how to run a stall successfully.
